Purpose: To practice with JavaScript Array, String, Math, and Date objects.

Note: as long as you meet the specifications below, you may add additional embellishments as you wish.

How to turn this in: See instructions in #3 below - you will e-mail me the URL's for your completed pages.

- 1. Create a web page of your choice; in it, either **create** a new array, or **use** one of the **document** object's properties that happens to be an array. Display on your page the contents of that array.
- 2. Create a web page of your choice; ask the user for some string. Then display their string back to them in all-uppercase; and then do whatever additional thing(s) you wish with that string using at least one other String method, displaying that/those results to the screen as well.
- 3. Create a web page of your choice; in it, obtain the current date, and DISPLAY something about that date to the screen, using at least one Date method. (You could print the current day of the week with the help of a Date method and an array, or the current month, or the current time... your choice!)
- **4.** Create a web page of your choice; in it, display the results of calling at least one Math method.
