

**CIS 180 L - Intro to JavaScript - Fall 2006
Homework Assignment #9**

Due: THURSDAY, September 21st, beginning of class

Purpose: To practice with some JavaScript cookie-related capabilities

Note: as long as you meet the specifications below, you may add additional embellishments as you wish.

How to turn this in: See instructions in final item below - you will e-mail me the URL's for your completed pages.

1. Create two web pages of your choice; in them:
 - * the first should set at least one cookie of your choice, using `document.cookie`;
 - * the second should try to retrieve the value of that cookie and do something visible with it (`document.write` a message displaying its value, etc.)

These two pages can be independent to one another --- one need not necessarily lead to another.

2. Now create three web pages of your choice, where each "leads" deliberately to the next. (You can make this connection however you'd like, and there are several ways to do it --- the first page could have an `<a href>` link to the second, and the second could have an `<a href>` link to the third, OR one could change the **location** object's **href** property (`location.href`) in one page to lead to the next, OR one could have a form that, when submitted, leads to the next as its action, and I'm sure there are other ways, too. You may mix and match as desired.)
 - * the first should set at least one cookie of your choice, using `document.cookie`;
 - * the second should try to retrieve the value of that cookie and do something visible with it (and may change it if you'd like);
 - * and the third should try to retrieve the value of that cookie and do something visible with it (and may change it if you'd like).
