

**CIS 180 L - Intro to PHP - Fall 2006
Homework Assignment #3**

Due: TUESDAY, November 9th, beginning of class

Purpose: To practice reading a form using PHP

Note: as long as you meet the specifications below, you may add additional embellishments as you wish.

How to turn this in: See instructions in #3 below - you will e-mail me the URL's for your completed pages.

1. Create a new HTML form with at least two textfields and at least one submit button. Place this on sorrel. Have its action refer to a new PHP page on redwood.
2. Create the PHP page on redwood for the action of your form from #1. Read the values of the textfields filled in on the submitted form, and display those values in some visible way on the resulting page. Include at least one loop or one if-statement within your PHP (that is, respond in a different way based on what the user enters).

(examples: have a numeric field, and react differently based on the number typed;
have a numeric field, and print something a certain number of times based on what they typed;
have a textfield, and if the text is a certain value, respond a certain way; etc.)
