Purpose: practice with PHP and sessions

Hoo-hah -- **try_trio.php** successfully demonstrates using **session_start()** and **\$_SESSION** to pass information between a sequence of 4 "screens" ("trio" in this name refers to the three questions asked of the user... 8-)) You can find its code along with this handout --- you can run it using:

For this assignment, construct a different sequence of at least 4 "screens", in which:

- * at least one piece of information is obtained from the 1st "screen" and visibly used in the 3rd and/or 4th screen because it has been appropriately stored within the **\$_SESSION** array during the 2nd screen;
- * either a hidden parameter or another **\$_SESSION** variable (or, even both, if you'd like) are used to help control what screen appears next;
- * use functions for each screen to better modularize your code, make it more readable, and better manage complexity.
