

**CIS 180 L - Intro to PHP - Fall 2006  
Homework Assignment #9**

**Due: THURSDAY, December 7th, beginning of class**

**Purpose:** practice working with files in PHP

**Note:** as long as you meet the specifications below, you may add additional embellishments as you wish.

**How to turn this in:** See instructions below - you will e-mail me the URL's for your completed pages.

1. Create a PHP page \*on redwood\* that prints a form showing radio buttons for at least three files of your choice, a textfield requesting how many lines should be displayed, and a submit button.

When the form is submitted, it should cause up to the specified number of lines from the selected file to be displayed on the web page. (That is, if the number given is more than the number of lines in the file, it just shows as much as it can... 8-)

2. Select a web page (not on redwood) for which it is reasonable to grab some information. Create a PHP page \*on redwood\* that attempts to open the URL for that web page and then reads and displays something of your choice from that web page. (This could be as simple as the first line of that URL's web page, or it could be something you deliberately glean from searching for something in particular within the web page, your choice.)
