
* No scientists are toddlers.

All physicists are scientists.

So, some physicists are not toddlers.



- * can we conclude that some physicists are not toddlers?
 - * NO, INVALID: "The conclusion states that some physicists are not toddlers.

This means there SHOULD be an X in the part of the Physicists circle that does NOT overlap with the Toddlers circle.

...there are NO X's at ALL in the diagram.

Hence, the argument is INVALID.
